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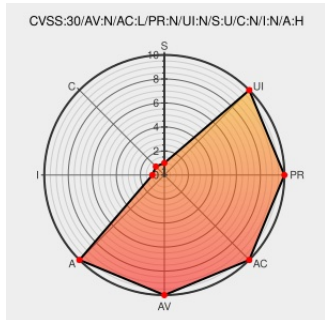

Certain versions of [Epicentro](#) from [Adbglobal](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Buffer Overflow in httpd in EpiCentro E_7.3.2+ allows attackers to cause a denial of service attack remotely via a specially crafted GET request with a leading "/" in the URL.

CVE-2018-7632 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
