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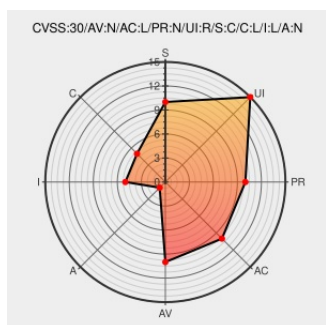

In YzmCMS 3.6, index.php has XSS via the a, c, or m parameter.
