Certain versions of [Monstra](#) from [Monstra](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Monstra CMS 3.0.4 allows remote code execution via an upload_file request for a .zip file, which is automatically extracted and may contain .php files.

CVE-2018-9037 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
