

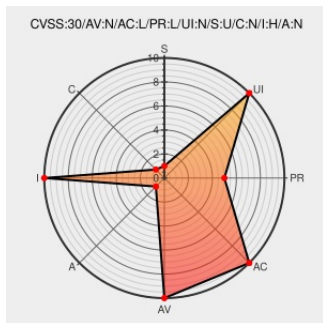

Certain versions of [Monstra](#) from [Monstra](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Monstra CMS 3.0.4 allows remote attackers to delete files via an admin/index.php?id=filesmanager&delete_dir=./&path=uploads/request.

CVE-2018-9038 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
