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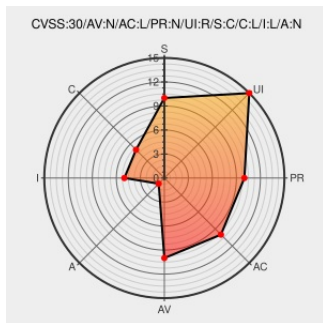

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Certain versions of [Samsung Mobile](#) from [Samsung](#) contain the following vulnerability:

On Samsung mobile devices with M(6.0) software, the Email application allows XSS via an event attribute and arbitrary file loading via a src attribute, aka SVE-2017-10747.

CVE-2018-9140 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
