

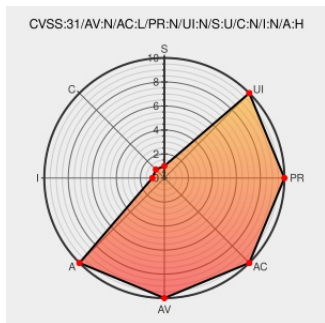

Certain versions of [Ubuntu Linux](#) from [Canonical](#) contain the following vulnerability:

ncmcp through 0.29 is prone to a NULL pointer dereference flaw. If a user uses the chat screen and another client sends a long chat message, a crash and denial of service could occur.

CVE-2018-9240 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
