Certain versions of [Kotti](#) from [Kotti Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Kotti before 1.3.2 and 2.x before 2.0.0b2 has CSRF in the local roles implementation, as demonstrated by triggering a permission change via a `/admin-document/@@share` request.

CVE-2018-9856 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
