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Certain versions of [Dolibarr](#) from [Dolibarr](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Dolibarr 7.0.0 is affected by: Cross Site Request Forgery (CSRF). The impact is: allow malicious html to change user password, disable users and disable password encryption. The component is: Function User password change, user disable and password encryption. The attack vector is: admin access malicious urls.

CVE-2019-1010054 has been assigned by [GSD](#) [cve-assign@distributedweaknessfiling.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
