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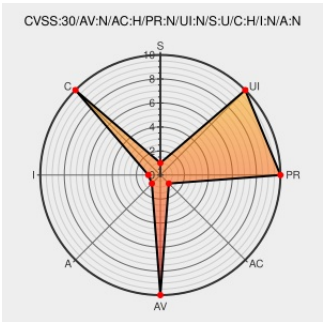

Certain versions of [Uc Browser](#) from [Ucweb](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The UCWeb UC Browser application through 2019-03-26 for Android uses HTTP to download certain modules associated with PDF and Microsoft Office files (related to libpicisel), which allows MITM attacks.

CVE-2019-10251 has been assigned by [M cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
