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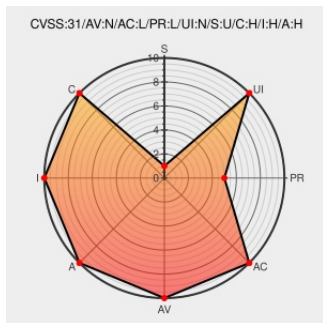

Certain versions of [Script Security](#) from [Jenkins](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A sandbox bypass vulnerability in Jenkins Script Security Plugin 1.61 and earlier related to the handling of method pointer expressions allowed attackers to execute arbitrary code in sandboxed scripts.

CVE-2019-10356 has been assigned by [jenkinsci-cert@googlegroups.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
