Certain versions of [Isob](#) from [Isob Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

All versions including 0.0.4 of Isob npm module are vulnerable to Command Injection. Every exported method used by the package uses the exec function to parse user input.

CVE-2019-10783 has been assigned by report@snyk.io to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
