Certain versions of [Blamer](#) from [Blamer Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Blamer versions prior to 1.0.1 allows execution of arbitrary commands. It is possible to inject arbitrary commands as part of the arguments provided to blamer.

CVE-2019-10807 has been assigned by [report@snyk.io](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
