

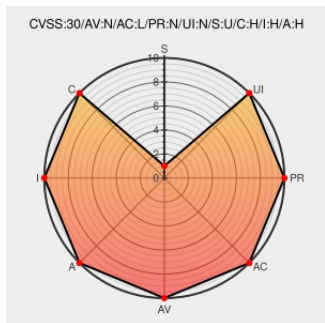

Certain versions of [Lightopenid](#) from [Lightopenid Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

openid.php in LightOpenID through 1.3.1 allows SSRF via a crafted OpenID 2.0 assertion request using the HTTP GET method.

CVE-2019-11066 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
