

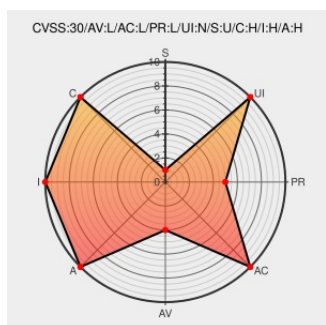

Certain versions of [Windows 7](#) from [Microsoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An elevation of privilege vulnerability exists in Windows when the Win32k component fails to properly handle objects in memory, aka 'Win32k Elevation of Privilege Vulnerability'.

CVE-2019-1132 has been assigned by secure@microsoft.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
