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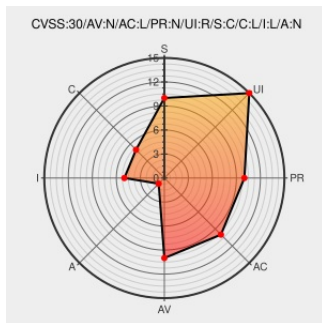

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Certain versions of [Fusionpbx](#) from [Fusionpbx](#) contain the following vulnerability:

XSS in `app/operator_panel/index_inc.php` in the Operator Panel module in FusionPBX 4.4.3 allows remote unauthenticated attackers to inject arbitrary JavaScript characters by placing a phone call using a specially crafted caller ID number. This can further lead to remote code execution by chaining this vulnerability with a command injection

vulnerability also present in FusionPBX.

CVE-2019-11408 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
