

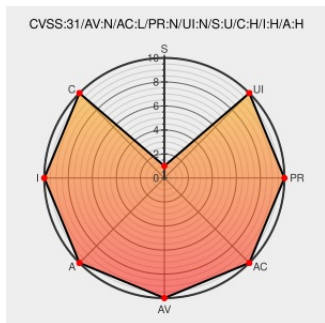

Certain versions of [Debian Linux](#) from [Debian](#) contain the following vulnerability:

gpg-key2ps in signing-party 1.1.x and 2.x before 2.10-1 contains an unsafe shell call enabling shell injection via a User ID.

CVE-2019-11627 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
