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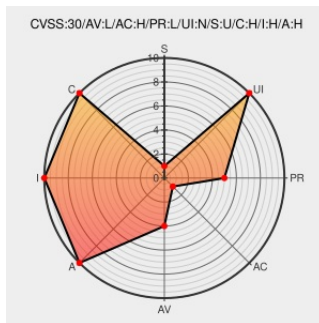

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Certain versions of [Groonga-httpd](#) from [Groonga](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The groonga-httpd package 6.1.5-1 for Debian sets the /var/log/groonga ownership to the groonga account, which might let local users obtain root access because of unsafe interaction with logrotate. For example, an attacker can exploit a race condition to insert a symlink from /var/log/groonga/httpd to /etc/bash_completion.d.

NOTE: this is an issue in the Debian packaging of the Groonga HTTP server.

CVE-2019-11675 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
