

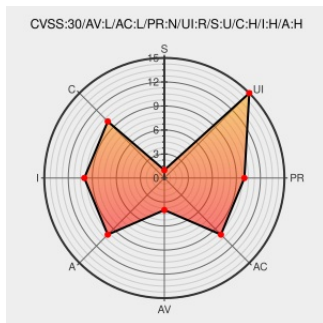

Certain versions of [Office](#) from [Microsoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A remote code execution vulnerability exists in Microsoft Outlook software when it fails to properly handle objects in memory, aka 'Microsoft Outlook Remote Code Execution Vulnerability'.

CVE-2019-1200 has been assigned by [secure@microsoft.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
