

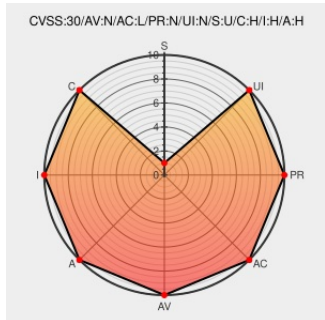

Certain versions of [Windows Server 2008](#) from [Microsoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A memory corruption vulnerability exists in the Windows Server DHCP service when an attacker sends specially crafted packets to a DHCP server, aka 'Windows DHCP Server Remote Code Execution Vulnerability'.

CVE-2019-1213 has been assigned by [secure@microsoft.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
