

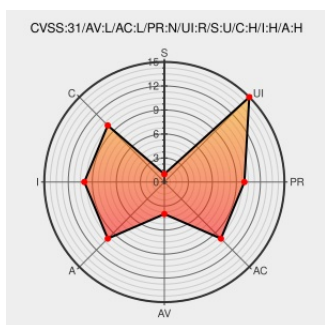

Certain versions of [Proshow Producer](#) from [Photodex](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in Photodex ProShow Producer v9.0.3797 (an application that runs with Administrator privileges). It is possible to perform a buffer overflow via a crafted file.

CVE-2019-12788 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
