Certain versions of [Network Performance Monitor Orion Platform 2018 Netpath](#) from [Solarwinds](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SolarWinds Network Performance Monitor (Orion Platform 2018, NPM 12.3, NetPath 1.1.3) allows XSS by authenticated users via a crafted onerror attribute of a VIDEO element in an action for an ALERT.

CVE-2019-12954 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
