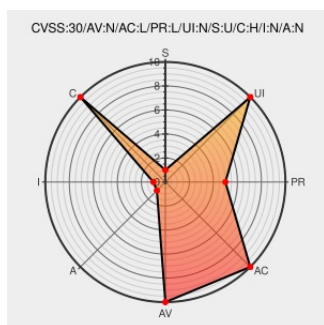

Certain versions of [Send Anywhere](#) from [Send-anywhere](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Send Anywhere application 9.4.18 for Android stores confidential information insecurely on the system (i.e., in cleartext), which allows a non-root user to find out the username/password of a valid user via

/data/data/com.estmob.android.sendanywhere/shared_prefs/sendanywhere_device.xml.

CVE-2019-13100 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
