

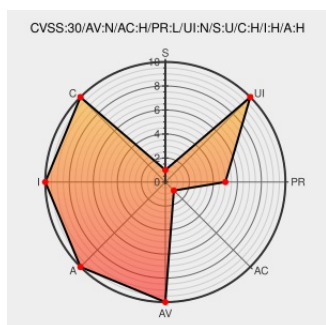

Certain versions of [Centos Web Panel](#) from [Centos-webpanel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In CentOS-WebPanel.com (aka CWP) CentOS Web Panel 0.9.8.836, a cwpsrv-xxx cookie allows a normal user to craft and upload a session file to the /tmp directory, and use it to become the root user.

CVE-2019-13359 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
