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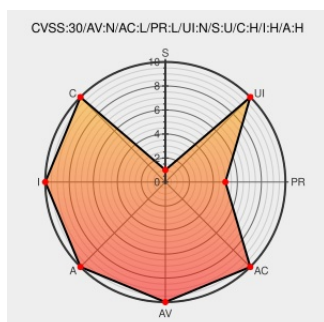

Certain versions of **Av7000** from **Datalogic** contain the following vulnerability:

Datalogic AV7000 Linear barcode scanner all versions prior to 4.6.0.0 is vulnerable to authentication bypass, which may allow an attacker to remotely execute arbitrary code.

CVE-2019-13526 has been assigned by ics-cert@hq.dhs.gov to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
