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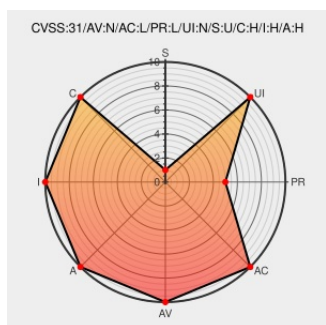

Certain versions of [Webaccess](#) from [Advantech](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In WebAccess versions 8.4.1 and prior, multiple command injection vulnerabilities are caused by a lack of proper validation of user-supplied data and may allow arbitrary file deletion and remote code execution.

CVE-2019-13552 has been assigned by ics-cert@hq.dhs.gov to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
