Certain versions of [Mark Vie Controll System](#) from [Ge](#) contain the following vulnerability:

GE Mark Vle Controller is shipped with pre-configured hard-coded credentials that may allow root-user access to the controller. A limited application of the affected product may ship without setup and configuration instructions immediately available to the end user. The bulk of controllers go into applications requiring the GE commissioning engineer to change default configurations during the installation process. GE recommends that users reset controller passwords during installation in the operating environment.

CVE-2019-13559 has been assigned by [@ics-cert@hq.dhs.gov](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
