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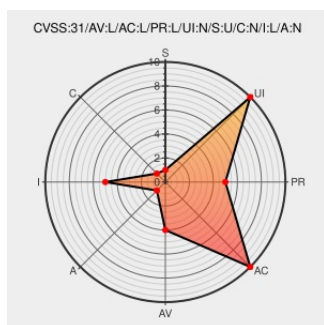

Certain versions of [Debian Linux](#) from [Debian](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Insufficient policy enforcement in downloads in Google Chrome on Windows prior to 79.0.3945.79 allowed a local attacker to spoof downloaded files via local code.

CVE-2019-13762 has been assigned by chrome-cve-admin@google.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **LOW** severity.
