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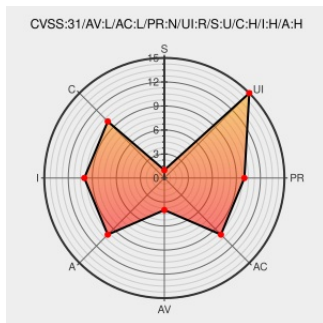

PDFResurrect 0.15 has a buffer overflow via a crafted PDF file because data associated with startxref and %%EOF is mishandled.

CVE-2019-14267 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
