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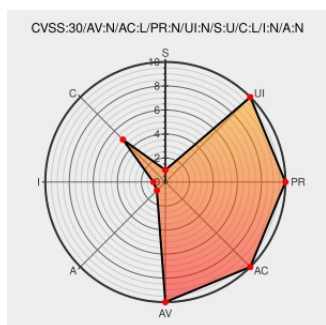

In Knowage through 6.1.1, an unauthenticated user can enumerated valid usernames via the ChangePwdServlet page.
