Certain versions of [Intercom](#) from [Intercom](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Intercom plugin through 1.2.1 for WordPress leaks a Slack Access Token in source code. An attacker can obtain a lot of information about the victim's Slack (channels, members, etc.).

CVE-2019-14365 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
