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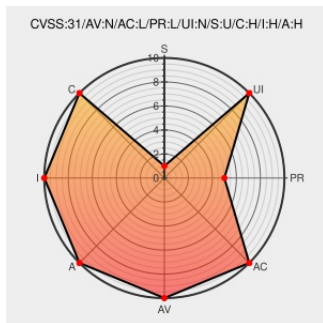

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Certain versions of **T49g** from **Yeahlink** contain the following vulnerability:

Yealink phones through 2019-08-04 do not properly check user roles in POST requests. Consequently, the default User account (with a password of user) can make admin requests via HTTP.

CVE-2019-14656 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
