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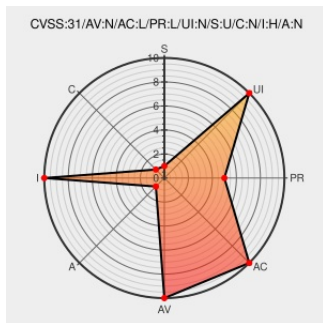

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Certain versions of [Centos Web Panel](#) from [Centos-webpanel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In CentOS-WebPanel.com (aka CWP) CentOS Web Panel 0.9.8.851, an insecure object reference allows an attacker to remove a target user from phpMyAdmin via an attacker account.

CVE-2019-14721 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
