

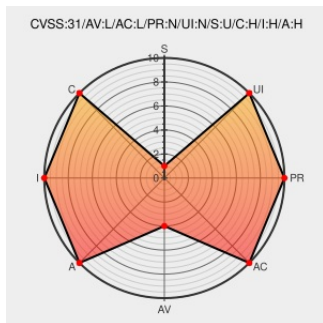


# CVE-2019-15017

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## CVE-2019-15017

Certain versions of [Inspector](#) from [Zingbox](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The SSH service is enabled on the Zingbox Inspector versions 1.294 and earlier, exposing SSH to the local network. When combined with PAN-SA-2019-0027, this can allow an attacker to authenticate to the service using hardcoded credentials.

CVE-2019-15017 has been assigned by psirt@paloaltonetworks.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.

CVSS3 Score: **8.4 - HIGH**
