Certain versions of [Galaxy J7 Max](#) from [Samsung](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Samsung J7 Max Android device with a build fingerprint of

samsung/j7maxlteins/j7maxlte:8.1.0/M1AJQ/G615FXXU2BSB1:user/release-keys contains a pre-installed app with a package name of com.samsung.android.themecenter app (versionCode=7000100, versionName=7.0.1.0) that allows other pre-installed apps to perform app installation via an accessible app component. This capability can be accessed by any pre-installed app on the device which can obtain signatureOrSystem permissions that are required by other other pre-installed apps that exported their capabilities to other pre-installed app.

CVE-2019-15443 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
