

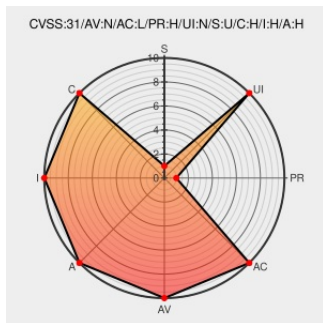

Certain versions of [Fortimail](#) from [Fortinet](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An improper access control vulnerability in FortiMail admin webUI 6.2.0, 6.0.0 to 6.0.6, 5.4.10 and below may allow administrators to access web console they should not be authorized for.

CVE-2019-15712 has been assigned by psirt@fortinet.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
