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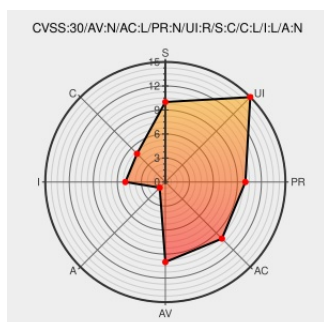

The nd-donations plugin before 1.4 for WordPress has a nopriv_ AJAX action that allows modification of the siteurl setting.
