

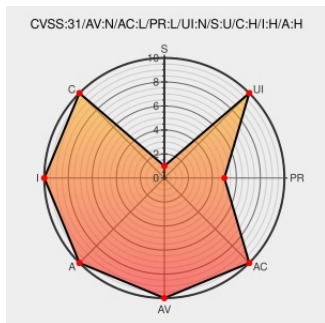

Certain versions of [Sentrifugo](#) from [Sentrifugo](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple file upload restriction bypass vulnerabilities in Sentrifugo 3.2 could allow authenticated users to execute arbitrary code via a webshell.

CVE-2019-15813 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
