Certain versions of [Youphptube](#) from [Youphptube](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In YouPHPTube 7.4, the file `install/checkConfiguration.php` has no access control, which leads to everyone being able to edit the configuration file, and insert malicious PHP code.

CVE-2019-16124 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
