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Certain versions of [Pega Platform](#) from [Pega](#) contain the following vulnerability:

**** DISPUTED **** PEGA Platform 7.x and 8.x is vulnerable to Information disclosure via a direct `prweb/sso/random_token/!STANDARD?`

`pyActivity=GetWebInfo&target=popup&pzHarnessID=random_harness_id` request to get database schema information while using a low-privilege account. NOTE: The vendor states that this vulnerability was discovered using an administrator account and they are normal administrator functions. Therefore, the claim that the CVE was done with a low privilege account is incorrect.

CVE-2019-16386 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
