

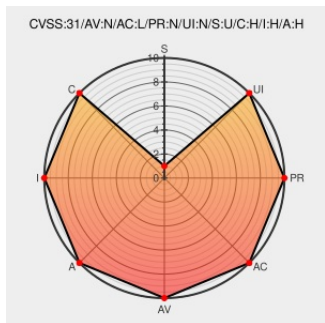

Certain versions of [Phpipam](#) from [Phpipam](#) contain the following vulnerability:

phpIPAM 1.4 allows SQL injection via the app/admin/custom-fields/edit.php table parameter when action=add is used.

CVE-2019-16696 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
