

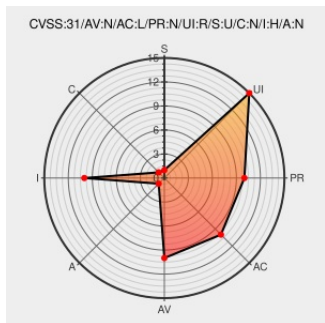

Certain versions of [Wtcms](#) from [Wtcms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

WTCMS 1.0 allows `index.php?g=admin&m=index&a=index` CSRF with resultant XSS.

CVE-2019-16719 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
