

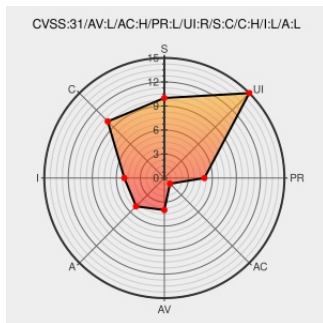

Certain versions of [Ezmaster](#) from [Inist](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The admin sys mode is now conditional and dedicated for the special case. By default, since ezmaster@5.2.11 no instance (container) is launched with advanced capabilities (not launched as root)

CVE-2019-16767 has been assigned by [security-advisories@github.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
