

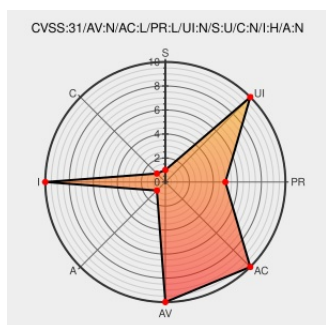

Certain versions of [Koji](#) from [Koji Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Koji through 1.18.0 allows remote Directory Traversal, with resultant Privilege Escalation.

CVE-2019-17109 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
