

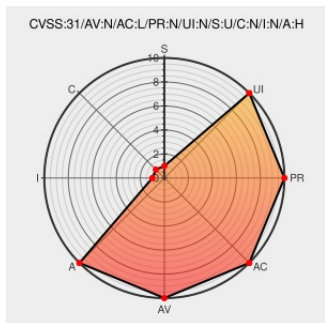

Certain versions of [Reader](#) from [Foxitsoftware](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Foxit Reader before 9.7 allows an Access Violation and crash if insufficient memory exists.
