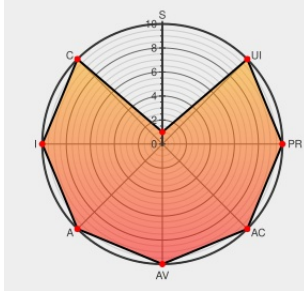

Certain versions of [Yachtcontrol](#) from [Yachtcontrol](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Yachtcontrol through 2019-10-06: It's possible to perform direct Operating System commands as an unauthenticated user via the `/pages/systemcall.php?command={COMMAND}` page and parameter, where `{COMMAND}` will be executed and returning the results to the client. Affects Yachtcontrol web servers disclosed via Dutch GPRS/4G mobile IP-ranges. IP addresses vary due to DHCP client leasing of telco's.

CVE-2019-17270 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
