Certain versions of [Vino](#) from [Vino Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

tinytcl Vino through 2017-12-15 allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service ("vn_get_string error: Resource temporarily unavailable" error and daemon crash) via a long URL.

CVE-2019-17414 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
