

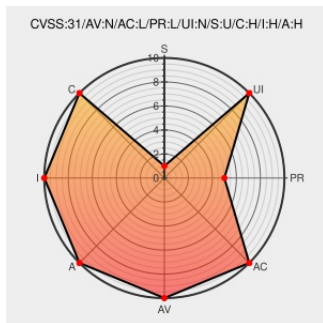

Certain versions of [Infobusiness](#) from [Zucchetti](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Zucchetti InfoBusiness before and including 4.4.1 allows any authenticated user to upload .php files in order to achieve code execution.

CVE-2019-18204 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
