

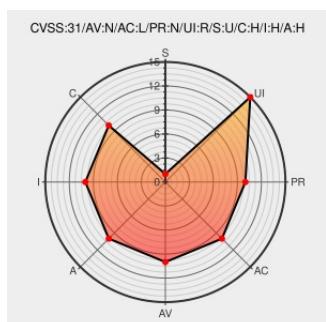

Certain versions of [Infobusiness](#) from [Zucchetti](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A cross-site request forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in Zucchetti InfoBusiness before and including 4.4.1 allows arbitrary file upload.

CVE-2019-18206 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
