

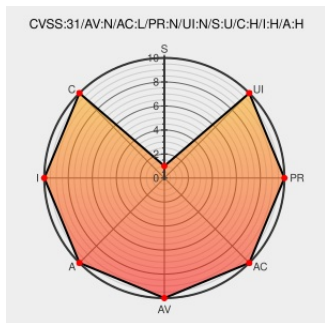

Certain versions of [V-server](#) from [Fujielectric](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In Fuji Electric V-Server 4.0.6 and prior, several heap-based buffer overflows have been identified, which may allow an attacker to remotely execute arbitrary code.

CVE-2019-18240 has been assigned by ics-cert@hq.dhs.gov to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
