Certain versions of [Pimcore](#) from [Pimcore](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Pimcore before 6.2.2 allow attackers to brute-force (guess) valid usernames by using the 'forgot password' functionality as it returns distinct messages for invalid password and non-existing users.

CVE-2019-18986 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
